### Report of Workshop on “Enhancing quality of teaching learning process”

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) conducted a Workshop on Enhancing the quality of teaching learning process to the faculty members on 12-11-2022 at 10am in the MBA Seminar Hall. The Resource Persons were Dr. B. Venkatachalapathy, Vice-Chancellor, Dr. S. Ravi, Director, IQAC, Mr. T. Shanmugavel, Coordinator IQAC. Dr. K. Sathishkumar, Coordinator, IQAC, Mr. K. Kathirvel, Coordinator, IQAC and Mr. C. Nithiyapathy, Coordinator, IQAC. In total, 58 faculty members attended the workshop.

In the opening remarks, the Vice-Chancellor conveyed the message that the Institution is very much focusing on strengthening the teaching learning process. He pointed out that the quality of the teacher plays significant role in this.


The Director, IQAC stressed that the periodic update of the recent developments by the faculty members is very much essential to keep up the pace with the growing technological advancements. He called for the capacity development of the faculty members on regular basis.

The participants were enlightened on the following points:

1. Hand Written Notes is a must for the beginners. While taking notes multiple books have to be referred.
2. The lecture plan has to be prepared before the commencement of the courses.
3. The teaching learning process has to be taken up seriously.
4. Student Centric Method has to be adopted while teaching and records to be maintained.
5. The delivery by the faculty members must be strong.
6. Recent trends/innovations and learning in the previous class to be discussed before the commencement of the actual lecturing.
7. Class control is very much essential and the student must be engaged in any way.
8. The voice must be audible to the entire class room.
9. The faculty should have in depth knowledge and approach in the class to be good.
10. Remedial Class has to be conducted for the slow learners.
11. Documentation of any activity related to teaching learning process assumes top priority.

The workshop was very much participative by all the participants and useful for the participants especially for the beginners. The ethical and behavioral aspects also were dealt with.
