To consider and approve the Activity Report of IQAC for the period from March 2025 to June 2025.

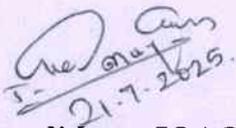
Resolution 2:

The details of the discussion had during the interaction are given below:

1. The criteria for availing seed money for the students to undertake their project work to be prepared.
2. Proposals for appointment of Associate and Assistant Professors of Practice can be submitted by the Departments of the Faculty of Engineering.
3. Possibility for providing training at the industry for specialised tools like Tally and giving credits is to be studied.
4. The usage of Language Lab is to be made effective for the benefit of the students across the institution.
5. One of the members suggested that for incorporating minor changes/corrections, the Academic Regulations may be amended instead of revising as practised now.
6. Establishment of Student Chapters of Professional Bodies is to be encouraged.

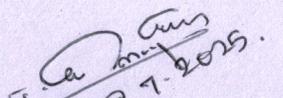

1.	Seed money may be provided for the students also.	It is suggested to select a few final year projects for providing seed money to start with.
2.	It was suggested to get a mentor from the respective internship providing organisation to monitor and evaluate the performance of the students who are undergoing internship.	Departments are collecting the details of the mentor from the respective industries.
3.	It was proposed to offer the Value -Added Courses within 4th semester for a 3year programme and within 6th semester for a 4year programme.	In 2024-2025, Value- Added Courses were offered within the 4 th semester for 3-year programmes and within the 6 th semester for 4-year programmes.
4.	The Faculty of Engineering may appoint not only PoP but also Associate and Assistant Professors of Practice as per the guidelines from AICTE.	The Departments of FoE are identifying the PoP from industry for appointing as Associate and Assistant Professors of Practice.
5.	Inspite of the focused training, students lack in the communication skills which may duly be addressed.	1. Students are asked to give a talk for 5 minutes at the beginning of each Lecture hour. 2. Training for IELTS has been started. 3. 266 Engineering students from 2024 – 2025 batch cleared a course on “Soft Skills” conducted by NPTEL.
6	Training may be imparted in Advanced Excel, Analytics, Python etc., which is required for industry.	1.In commerce, training was given in Advanced Excel, Tally Prime and Digital Marketing. 2.Advanced Excel is included in 2025-2026 curriculum of CS stream 3. Workshop was conducted in Python, Web Development for Computer Science stream
