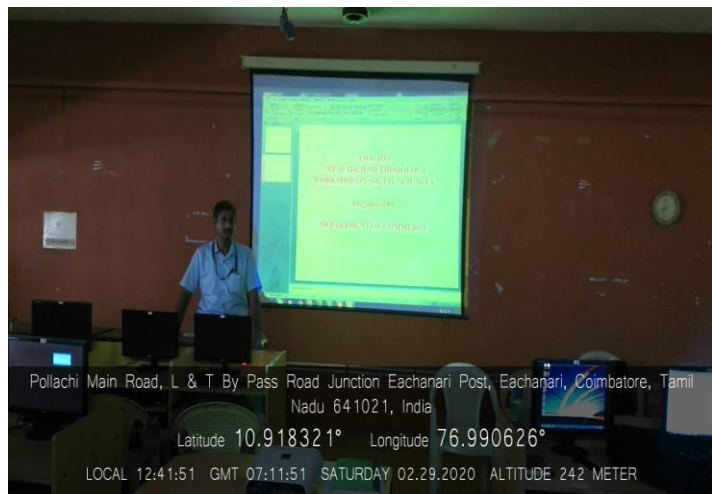


Report on Research Methodology Workshop on Social Science
