3.6.1. Extension activities in the neighbourhood community in terms of impact and sensitising students to social issues and holistic development during the last five years

The objective of the extension programme is to take the educational advantages to the people in the neighbourhood community. Extension is generally thought of at two levels, extension education and extension service. The field extension work of the institutions and organizations is generally limited to the neighboring villages or blocks, which are considered as their extension laboratories.

Our extension, NSS, NCC activities are mainly carried out in the five adapted villages Nachipalayam, Arisipalayam, Seerapalayam, Malumichampatti and Othakalmandapam.

The students, staff and village people combined together with many NGO's, government and other private bodies they actively participated in all Swatch BharathAbiyan, UnnatBharathAbhiyan and Swatch Pakwada activities. 120 Students registered for Swatch Bharath Summer internship programme. They successfully completed the 100 hours training programme in the adopted village with various health, hygiene, environmental and social awareness activities. Also street plays and movie screening are also done to impart the social and environmental values to the public.

Swachh Survekshan Ranking 2018 for Schools/Hospitals was done by our 500 NSS volunteers along with Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation. Our NSS volunteers actively participated in the survey. The survey is conducted in 197 Government and Private schools in the Coimbatore city limit. The volunteers framed "Swachhata Committee" for the school and also they personally inspected the school regarding cleanliness, hygiene, water facility and waste management system.

Today need is energy conservation and use of new renewable energy. So we conducted programme for energy conservation and usage of new renewable energy in our adopted villages. Awareness programmes on solar energy are also conducted. Students are explained about the importance of English language. Programmes were conducted to teach basic grammar to the students which will help them to speak in English without any inhibition. Also the school teachers are trained with mobile applications and tools in the area of today's need.

Various health and medical camps were organized in the adopted villages along with government and private medical bodies. The camps helped the poor people to improve their personal health. The camps also created awareness about prevention and protection from many communicable and non-communicable diseases. Our students always volunteer the needy people in the government and private hospitals by donating blood round the year.

Also many social awareness programmes were organized such as tobacco free village, open defecation, solid waste management, plastic eradication, tree plantation, conservation of water resources in the adopted villages. The following awareness programmes also initiated in the adopted villages such as environmental pollution and its control measures, smart phone applications, Child obesity prevention, Breast cancer awareness, breast feeding awareness, Vigilance awareness, Organ donation awareness, Sanitation awareness and Legal literacy.

Volunteers also render their helping hands spontaneously at the time of crisis created by natural calamities to their maximum with money, material and food items. Volunteers always focus on green and clean environment not only in the adopted villages but also in their our institutions.

DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM ON "MUSHROOM CULTIVATION"

Department of Biotechnology (B.Tech) has organized an extension activity on 05.02.2020 at Arisipalayam with two faculty members (Ms.T.V.Jemilakshmi and Ms.K.Santhiya) and 26 students.

Mushroom grows naturally in the temperate and tropical forests on dead and decaying wooden logs or sometimes on dying trunks of deciduous or coniferous woods. It may also grow on decaying organic matter. The fruit bodies of this mushroom are distinctly shell or spatula shaped with different shades of white, cream, grey, yellow, pink or light brown depending upon the species. It is one of the most suitable fungal organisms for producing protein rich food from various agro-wastes or forest wastes without composting.

The main objective of this program is to train the rural people in production, processing and value addition to generate additional income by sustainable utilization of natural resources and better utilization of waste/agricultural byproducts. The technologies were chosen in such a way that they are easy for the participants to learn and the trained people can start a business with minimum initial investment (Oyster mushroom cultivation) and realize the profit in shorter time.

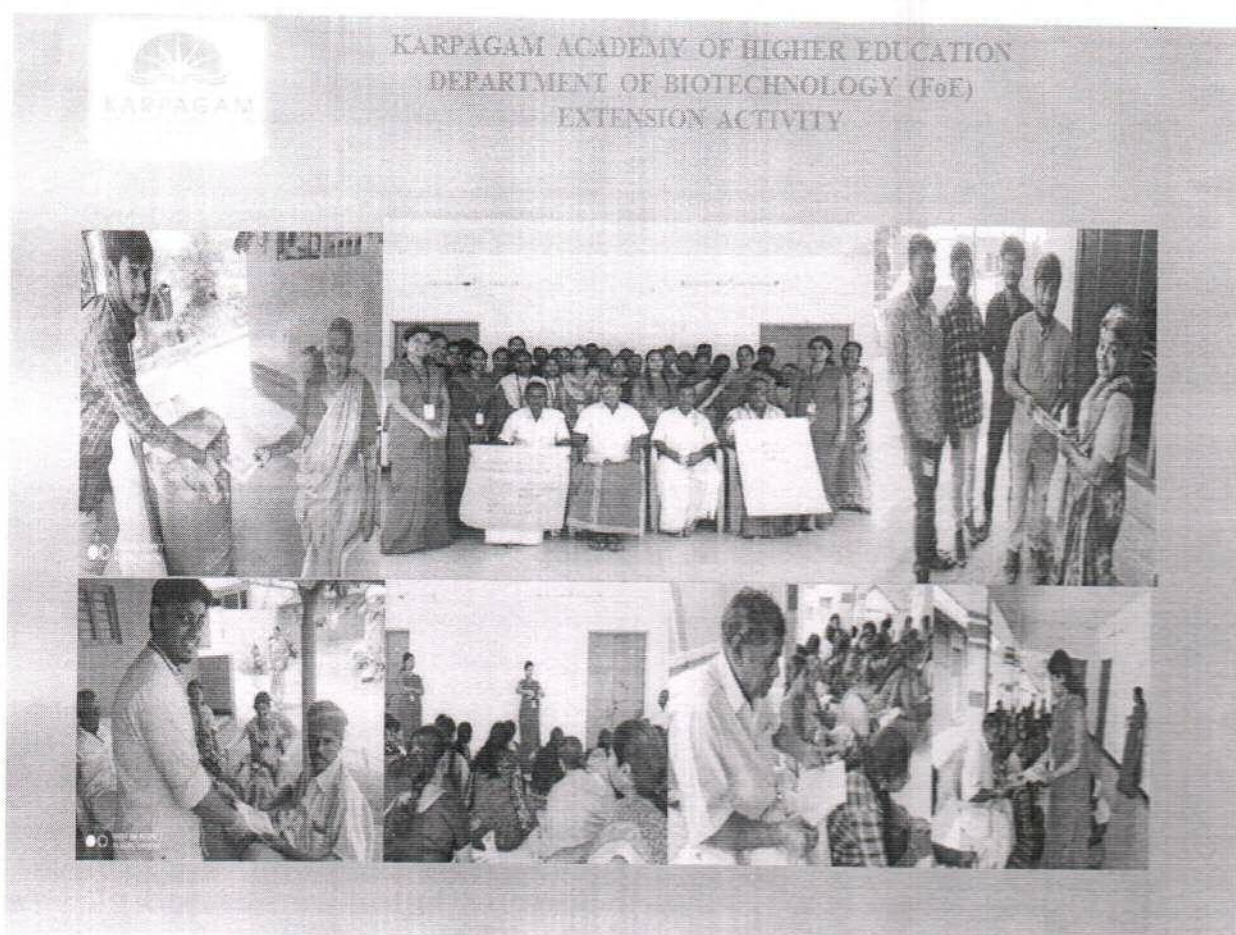


