To throw light among the students on entrepreneurship, Department of Management, Karpagam Academy of Higher Education organized a one-day workshop named "Igniting Entrepreneurial Skills" on Wednesday, the 11<sup>th</sup> October 2017 at Thiruvalluvar Hall. Students from various departments attended the workshop and around 15 students from other institutions have made their presence. All students were mainly enlightened on the role that entrepreneurs can play in the development of our nation and wide range of opportunities that a country like India can offer to its entrepreneurs.

## Forenoon - Session Three (Time: 10:00 am to 01:00 pm)

First Session was about Financial Assistance for start-ups. Mr. Ajay Kumar explained about various financial schemes available to entrepreneurs such as Credit Guarantee fund Trust Scheme for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (CGTMSE) provides a framework for the Banks to extend up to Rs.1 crore of loan without any collateral security towards term loan and working capital requirements of a business. Similarly the schemes like Pradhan Mantri MUDRA Yojana (PMMY) would help in facilitating micro credit up to 10 lakhs to small business owners, Startup India Scheme promotes bank financing for start-up ventures to boost entrepreneurship and encourage start ups with jobs creation. He mentioned available government subsidies to support entrepreneurship. Apart from that there are some specific schemes available for widows, divorced women and other schemes which promote's women entrepreneurship. He also stated the different methods to get loan from the bank and also about various types of loan available for new entrepreneurs. The session turned out to be an informative session for students in making them to understand about the various ways a bank can help them in starting their own business.

Second session was about Import and Export documentation. Mr. N. Kaleemullah, Founder of Agro Carbons and Horizon Training Academy was the resource person. He emphasized mainly about the export potential of agricultural products in India and how to identify suitable clients in abroad to export. He explained about the license and documentation procedures involved in export business. He has given detailed information about the pivotal documents required for export/import such as invoice, packing list, airway bill, Bill of Lading, Certificate of Origin, Letter of Credit, etc. Along with these points, he also shared various qualities needed to become a successful Entrepreneur with some interesting real time examples. He reiterated about the importance and significance of innovation which plays a crucial role in the success of every company. The Session was unique and interesting. Students learnt about the basic things needed for an entrepreneur to be successful.

## Afternoon - Session Three (Time: 02:00 pm to 03:30 pm)

Third session was handled by Mr. B. Nagaraj, CEO of Latha InfoTech, Coimbatore. He is a business consultant by profession. He shared about his business experience in Botswana, Africa. He encouraged the students not to get depressed during failures but to fight until success is reached with a small story that how his company was bankrupted in the year 2006 and how he had overcome that situation to now. He told that there are many countries in the world with good business opportunities like Africa, Europe, Russia, etc. He also motivated the students regarding confidence, time management, perfection and other leadership qualities to become a successful entrepreneur.

Fourth session was with Mr. B. Bala Senthil Kumar, who was also the MBA alumnus of Karpagam Academy of Higher Education (Batch: 2011 – 13). The session was about self-development and personality development. According to him, an entrepreneur must have various skill sets to become a successful businessman. He listed out some essential skills like volunteering, positive attitude, listening skills, interpersonal skills, strong body language and good sense of humor. He highlighted about the importance of building a strong team for the success of an organization. The session was very useful and he gave new ideas to the students to start a business on their own.

Fifth session started as a discussion by Mrs. P. Shanmuga priya, making the student to understand the entire operational activities involved in starting a business. She shared her own experience from nascent stage to finally getting established in business. She mainly emphasized about the significant role that sales and marketing department plays in various stages like gaining customer attraction, understanding and satisfying the customer needs.




Further, she explained the process of producing a new product based on her own experience. The session was inspirational to the students acquiring knowledge on how to self-develop them.



At the end, the workshop ended successfully with the National Anthem.






Mr. M. Ajay Kumar, Regional Sales Manager, South Indian Bank delivers a lecture on "Financial Assistance for Start-ups"
