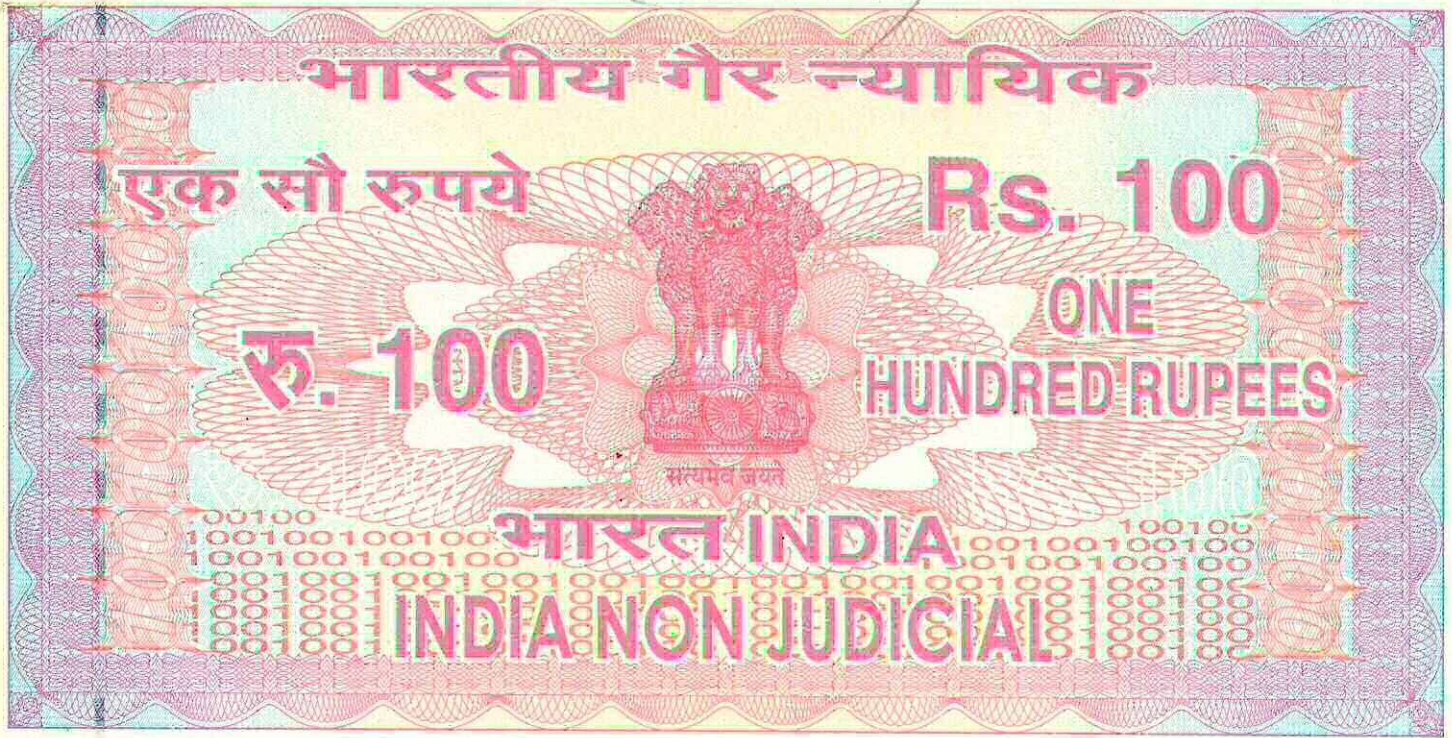

109/109 This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is entered at COIMBATORE on 20th March 2017 between MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTREPRISE - TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT CENTRE, MINISTRY OF MSME GOVERNMENT OF INDIA - FOUNDRY NAGAR, AGRA, represented by its PRINCIPAL DIRECTOR, Mr.R.Pannerselvam, hereinafter called the PARTY OF THE FIRST PART,

AND

KARPAGAM UNIVERSITY, KARPAGAM ACADEMY OF HIGHER EDUCATION, COIMBATORE having its Institution at POLLACHI MAINROAD, COIMBATORE - 641021, represented by its Head of the Institution, VICE CHANCELLOR, Dr.S.Sudalaimuthu, hereinafter called the PARTY OF THE SECOND PART.

It is effective upon signing and shall remain in effect for a period of three years or termination by either party within 30 days written notice whichever is earlier. This agreement may also be extended/modified at the end of the third year after review and if need is felt for extension of the agreement.


NOW THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:-

1. Scope : Area and Method of Co-operation.

The area of co-operation includes any programme offered by either of the participating parties determined to be desirable and feasible for developing co-operative relationships. The methods of co-operation include, subject to availability of funds and the approval of each institution, research, training and academic activities or programmes such as :-

1.1 Joint training courses, graduate and undergraduate student mobility such as internships, exchange and fellowships.

1.2 Participation in and co-hosting of Technical Exhibitions, lectures, Workshops, Seminars, Symposia and Conferences.

1.3 Exchange of materials, publications and other information, within limits of legal rules and regulations. *Publications*

1.4 Joint application for funding for collaborative projects from relevant funding agencies. *collaborative funding*

1.5 To institute Centre of Excellence at Karpagam University in the area of Industrial Automation and Robotics to start with. *Centre of Excellence*

1.6 Collaboration in other areas that foster research training and educational co-operation.

Terms of each activity or program including budget for each program and activity, shall be discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of the particular program or activity. All terms shall be negotiated on a mutual basis and documented in a project or program agreement. Such joint programs and resulting agreements shall specify the specific responsibilities and obligations of each party.

2. Intellectual Property

Procedures for the handling of intellectual property rights that may arise during the course of this collaboration shall be outlined in a separate document. All terms shall be negotiated on a mutual basis prior to the start of the collaborative project in questions and in accordance with the policies of each institution. *IPR*

3. Principles

Implementation of this MOU will be in accordance with the Policies on co-operation of the MSME – Technology Development Centre, Agra and relevant policies at the KARPAGAM UNIVERSITY, KARPAGAM ACADEMY OF HIGHER EDUCATION, COIMBATORE. Participants under this MOU will be selected on the basis of merit without regard to race, national or ethnic origin, colour, religion, age sex, sexual orientation, marital status or physical handicap and will each accept the participants selected by the other party if mutually acceptable academic and/or professional qualifications and standards are met. All participants will be treated in the same non-discriminatory manner in carrying out the provisions of the MOU, subject to the

provisions of the policies and requirements of each of the institutions. Any violation of these Principles will be considered grounds for terminating this MOU.

4. Terms of Co-operation

4.1 Length of Agreement

This Memorandum of Understanding will remain in force for a period of Three years from the date of signing.

4.2 Accountability

An activity report shall be submitted on an annual basis by the designated co-ordinators to each party and appended to this agreement.

4.3 Amendments

Any amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding will require written approval of each of the party. After the initial three year period, this Memorandum of Understanding may be renewed by mutual consent.

4.4 Termination



4.5 Language


This agreement is created in duplicates in English, each of those duplicates being deemed original.






