


Fig.6 Canteen




Fig.10 Day Care Center for Young Children

## Solid Waste Management

Solid wastes refer to waste paper, old answer scripts, old newspapers, broken glassware in the laboratory, plastics and waste construction materials.

Solid wastes such as construction materials including broken bricks, cement blocks, iron rods, shuttering wastes which form the major part are cleared by the building contractor as the entire construction related works are outsourced. The Institution does not deal with such type of solid wastes on its own.

Old newspapers and answer scripts are sold to vendors once in a year, after calling quotations in the sealed cover. The quotation will be opened by the Members of the Purchase Committee in the presence of vendors and the rate at which the old newspapers will be finalized after negotiation with vendors.

Tree leaves, wooden logs are stored in Vermi-compositing yards periodically. This composite manure is used as organic manures for trees, shrubs, grass and in herbal garden within the Institution. Excess manures are distributed to needy people in adopted villages.

## Liquid Waste Management

The Institution has installed two Sewage Treatment Plants with 3.5 lakhs capacity. Liquid wastes such as kitchen waste, dining hall waste, canteen liquid waste and used water are connected through pipeline and collected in the liquid collection tank and processed in the Sewage Treatment Plant (STP). This treated water is supplied through pipes to irrigate the garden, trees, landscaping etc. Solid wastes generated in the STP are disinfected and used as manure.
