He told that the government set an ambitious target of garnering Rs 72,500 crore through the disinvestment route in 2017-18, a 60 percent increase over the 2016-17 target of Rs 56,500 crore. He told that it was the highest ever divestment target set by any government in India outdoing the Rs 69,500 crore of 2015-16. This growth has increased as successive governments have forever failed to achieve these targets. Even in the current financial year, the government is hopeful of raising only Rs 45,500 crore, which would be 20 percent less than the target it had set at the start of the year. That, has been the government's best showing so far. In fiscals 2014-15 and 2015-16, the government did not even manage half of the targets. In the last 26 years, government has failed to achieve its target 17 times.

Tax expansion and measures include:

- PST will now be applied to children's clothing, restaurant meals and snack foods, insurance premiums, construction services and permanently mounted equipment used in the resource sector.
- Education Property Tax is increasing to provide 40 per cent of funding to K-12 education.
- The exemption for bulk purchases of gasoline is being eliminated.
- The exemption for bulk purchases of diesel fuel is being reduced to 80 per cent of purchases to reflect the changing nature of farming and primary production operations and on-road and personal use of this fuel.
- The exemption for used cars will continue, but the value of a trade-in will no longer be deductible in determining the PST on the purchase of a new vehicle.
- Tobacco taxes are increasing, as alcohol markups.
- Personal income tax credits for education and tuition expenses and the Employee Tool Tax Credit are being eliminated.
