

Bore well Rescue Device



The main objective of this device is to make it possible for a child fall inside bore well to rescue without any injury. This goal is achieved by controlling a device to take of the child inside the bore well which is controlled by the person from outside.



In existing system, a big hole is dug beside the bore well up to the depth where the child is stuck. A small delay in this resource's accumulation may reduce the chances of saving child alive. If the area beside the bore hole contains rocks below certain depth, in such cases the chance of saving child alive is very low. Lack of oxygen inside the bore well and lack of light sources causes the major difficulty during the rescue operation. There is no such special equipment for rescuing the child trapped inside the bore well. There is no proper technique to rescue victims of such accidents.



By considering these factors, we have designed and developed a device to rescue the child safely. Our device has inbuilt features like

1. CCTV Camera

Used to visualize the position of the child fall into the borewell and inner surface condition of the borewell.

2. Temperature Sensor

For measuring the temperature and humidity inside the borewell. Our sensor specially designed for borewell rescue system it can read temperature from -55°C to 150°C .



3. Proximity Sensor

For measuring the depth from ground surface to the locked position of the child inside the borewell. It can measure up to 600feet.

4. Gas Analyzer

For analysing the gases inside the borewell to decide the amount of oxygen supply. It is much needed because if harmful and flammable gases present inside the borewell it may cause fire accidents when it was reacted with supplied oxygen.

5. Oxygen Dispenser

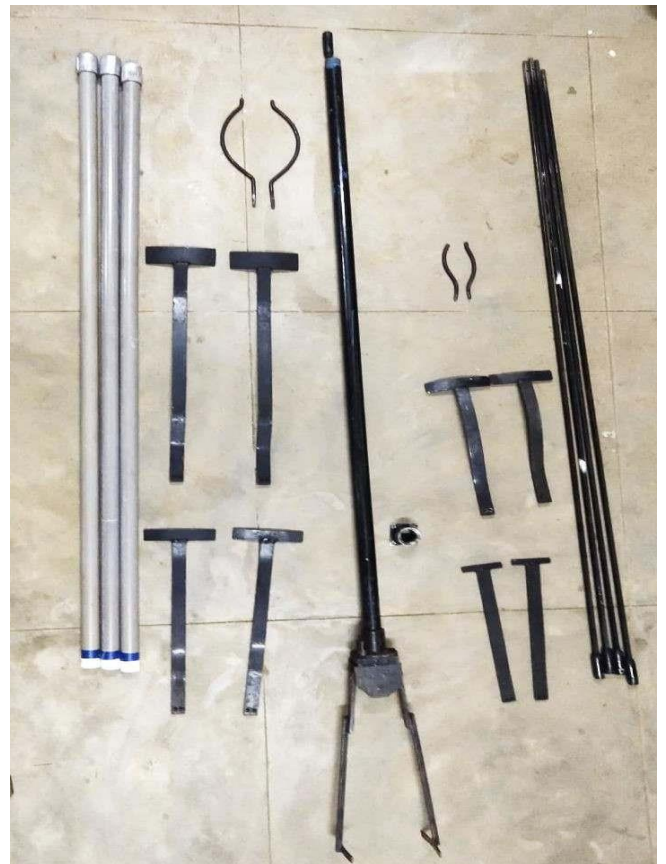
Based on report from the Gas analyser, oxygen dispenser supplies the required quantity of oxygen to the fallen child automatically without causing any hazardous environment inside the borewell.

6. Controller Unit

It receives signal from various sensor and transmit it to the display monitor. From monitor visualisation we can control all the actions inside the borewell from outside premises. With the help of Artificial intelligence, the controller itself suggest some safe methods in the monitor by understanding the child fallen position and borewell condition.

7. Simple Structure

Our rescue device made up of light weighted materials (PVC and Stainless steel). It can ability to rescue a child from 600feet depth borewell and the total assembly was divided into several modules. The connection between the modules are made up of simple mechanical locking system and doesn't require any tools to assemble and dismantle it. So, it is more compact and easily transportable.

8. Simple Mechanism

Except few electronic components, our system designed with simple mechanical elements and linkages because it doesn't require any power supply and control signal to work. Moreover, our device working principle was very simple, even a layman can operate our device without having any prior training.

9. Gripper Design

Gripper design is one of the intellectual ideas in our rescue device. We have dedicatedly designed and developed 16 different grippers for safely rescuing the fallen child from borewell. Based on the fallen position of the child we can choose proper gripper. Gripper selection information and guidance available in the monitor screen.

10. Suction Mechanism

Most of the borewell rescue operation failed due to the loose sand dumped over the fallen child. This dumping may occur mainly due to vibration caused nearer to the borewell. For that we have dedicatedly developed a mechanism to remove the loose sand over the child.

A lot of lives have been lost due to falling in the bore well because it involves digging a pit beside a bore well which is a time-consuming process. Our design is to overcome all these difficulties. This device is used to reduce human efforts for rescuing operations from bore well. It performs rescue operations in very less time as compared to traditional methods. Thus, it has been designed keeping the entire obstacle in mind that may arise during the operation.

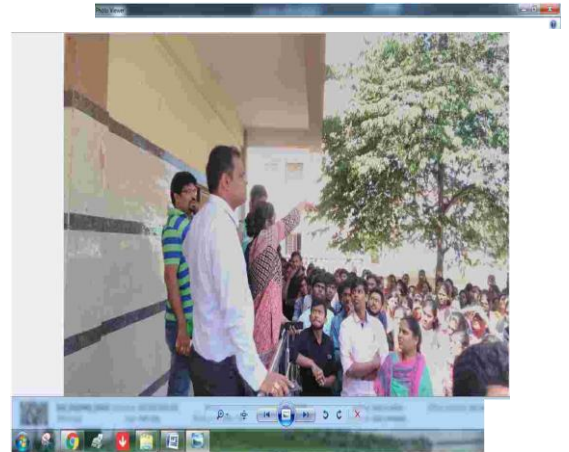

Research and Development Karpagam Cancer Research Centre

Karpagam Cancer Research Centre is established to provide scientific validation on indigenous herbs and to identify promising lead molecules as candidate drugs to existing drugs has laid foundation for this centre. The centre is actively working to delineate the cause for cancer and to improve the quality of life in individuals diagnosed with cancer.

It has the following units

Phyto-chemical isolation and characterization unit

Animal cell culture unit

Computational drug designing and development unit

Pre-clinical testing unit

Synthetic Chemistry unit

Surgical Oncology unit (Karpagam Faculty of Medical Sciences and Research)

According to World Health Organization (WHO), Cancer is a generic term for a large group of diseases characterized by the growth of abnormal cells beyond their usual boundaries that can then invade adjoining parts of the body and/or spread to other organs. WHO estimated Cancer as the second leading cause of death globally and accounted 9.6 million cancer related deaths in 2018. Lung, prostate, colorectal, stomach and liver cancer are the most common types of cancer in men, while breast, colorectal, lung, cervix and thyroid cancer are the most common among women. Faculty members from the department of Biochemistry, Bioinformatics, Biotechnology, Microbiology, Chemistry and Pharmacy are actively involved in the area of cancer research.

We have established a pathogen free environment for the maintenance of immune-compromised rats through individual ventilated caging (IVC) and adhere strictly to CPCSEA guidelines. The centre successfully developed humanized mice model system to study the *in vivo* efficacy of anti-cancer drugs. Prostate and cervical cancer tumor models are successfully created. KAHE has a established cell culture facility with state of the art equipments such as lyophilizers, real time thermal cycler, Chemidoc imaging system, ELISA reader, fluorescence imager, cooling centrifuges, CO₂ incubators, laminar flow hoods, deep freezers, dissolution apparatus for the execution of cell and molecular biology based experiments. Computational softwares, super computing systems were purchased to strengthen the *in silico* screening of compounds to identify lead candidate molecules. KAHE is registered to receive the cell lines from National Centre for Cell Sciences biorepository. The findings are published in reputed international journals for the past five years and three patents are filed in the area of cancer research. More than 30 publications are being made in the area of cancer research and three patents are being filed and published.

The institution is awaiting the grant of the patent. Faculty members of KAHE are also offering consultancy services in the area of cancer research for oncology researchers.

The centre is actively working to develop a novel drug using multi-disciplinary approach. Principal Investigators with expertise in phyto-pharmacology, computational biology, cell culture, animal models, molecular biology are working in tandem to accomplish the set objective. The centre is well equipped with state of the art research facilities in various disciplines. A bioassay guided fractionation approach using cell based assays and computational tools are being utilized to identify lead molecules, which are being tested in pre-clinical models. Further, the centre also analyzes the expression pattern of different protein molecules in the tissue samples excised during surgery after getting informed consent from the patient to understand the patho-physiology of various cancer types. So far the centre tested herbs such as *Annona Muricata*, *Plumbago Zylanica*, *Carica Papaya*, *Aloe Vera*, *Zaleya Decandra*, *Terminalia Arjuna*, *Phyllanthus niruri*, *Mimosa diplotricha* and identified lead molecules through in silico and in vitro approaches. In vivo approaches are also being currently pursued in this line. In addition to the indigenous herbs, the centre also evaluate the anticancer potency of isolated compounds such as Naringenin, EGCG, Trans-Cinnamaldehyde, Turmeric oil, Curcumin, Emodin, Aloe emodin, resveratrol, cordycepin, Ar-turmerone, hesperitin.

The centre envisages the identification and development of a new viable drug molecule.

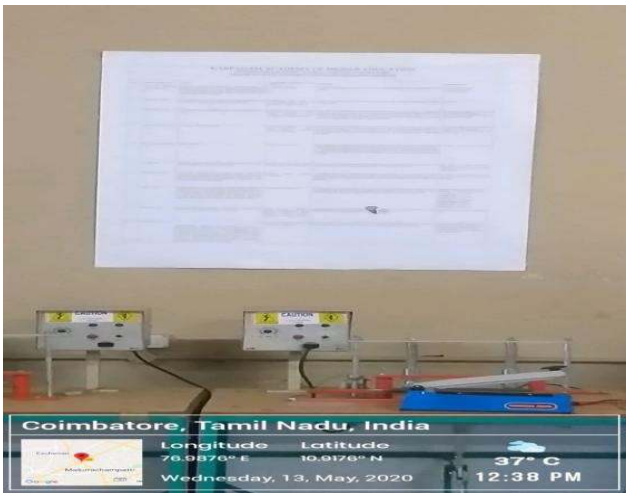
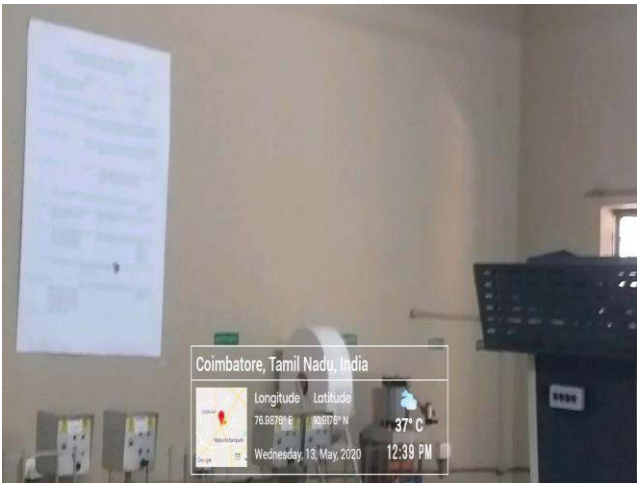

ABOUT KARPAGAM ACADEMY OF HIGHER EDUCATION

Karpagam Academy of Higher Education is located in a sprawling, green, lush campus extending 26 acres. It has emerged from Karpagam Arts & Science College (Autonomous) a unit under the Karpagam Charity Trust established in 1989 founded by the great philanthropist, industrialist and educationist Dr.R.Vasanthakumar with the vision of instilling originality in the learning minds, imparting quality and value-based education and to engage in Research and Development with the noble objective of creating unique men and women to serve and lead the society.

Karpagam Academy of Higher Education was conferred as Deemed to be University by the Ministry of Human Resource Development in August 2008 under section 3 of the UGC Act 1956. It is a recognised Deemed to be University by the UGC. It is a member of the Association of Indian Universities. The Institution has been accredited by the NAAC in 2015.

The Institution has 4 Faculty - Faculty of Arts, Science and Humanities, Faculty of Engineering, Faculty of Architecture and Faculty of Pharmacy. It has 25 Departments offering a wide range of 84 academic programmes from graduation to doctorate level. Faculty have got good number of research projects with financial support from various funding agencies like DBT / DST / ICMR and have filed more than 60 patents. As many as 2200 Research papers have been published by the faculty in SCOPUS. The Institution has collaborated with Foreign Universities, Industries, and Research Bodies for mutual benefit. The Institution install 49 KW of Solar Power Panel for generating electricity from renewable energy. 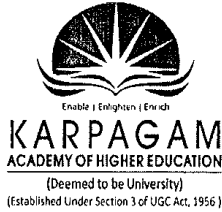

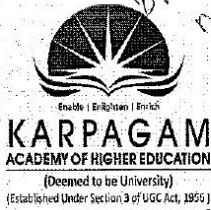

“Organ Donation Awareness Seminar”

“**National** Service Scheme and Department of Microbiology of Karpagam Academy of Higher Education, Coimbatore in association with Rajiv Gandhi Chronic Disease Health Care Awareness Association & Indira Gandhi Eye Bank of India Trust conducted “**Organ Donation Day Awareness Seminar**” on 13th August, 2018 at MBA Hall. It was organized to create awareness about organ donation in society. About 300 volunteers from various departments attended this seminar. It is expected that they will now help in educating others regarding the need for organ donation.

Sri C.P.Perumaal- Organizing Secretary, the Coordinator of Rajiv Gandhi Chronic Disease Health Care Awareness Association & Indira Gandhi Eye Bank of India Trust discussed government guidelines and initiatives in deceased donor organ donation.

The seminar was inaugurated by Registrar, Karpagam Academy of Higher Education.

Dr. J. K. B. C. Parthiban, Neuro & Spine Surgeon, Kovai Medical Centre & Hospital, Coimbatore enlightened the gathering about the importance of cadaver (brain-dead donor) donations. Organs such as the liver, heart, kidneys, pancreas, small bowel and corneas could be **retrieved from such donors**. “**Increasing awareness about cadaver organ donations can result in precious lives being saved. If all of us agree to donate our organs after death, perhaps this will be more successful,**” he emphasized. He elucidated the concept of brain death, the irreversible loss of all brain functions.

“**Brain death certification** is done after the patient satisfies certain irreversible criteria. The certification is carried out by a team of doctors appointed by the state, including a neurologist. The test is repeated after six **hours before certification is given,**” he shared.

Dr. Anand Vijay, Gem Hospital, Coimbatore, Liver Transplant Surgeon, spoke about preventive aspects of liver disease. In his speech about Liver Transplantation, he said Coimbatore hospitals have successfully harvested organs through 61 Cadaver transplantation, taking the number to 51 kidneys, 28 livers, 15 hearts and 2 lungs. Doctors from Coimbatore claim that the achievement had been successful because of the awareness among the public and the technology that is available.

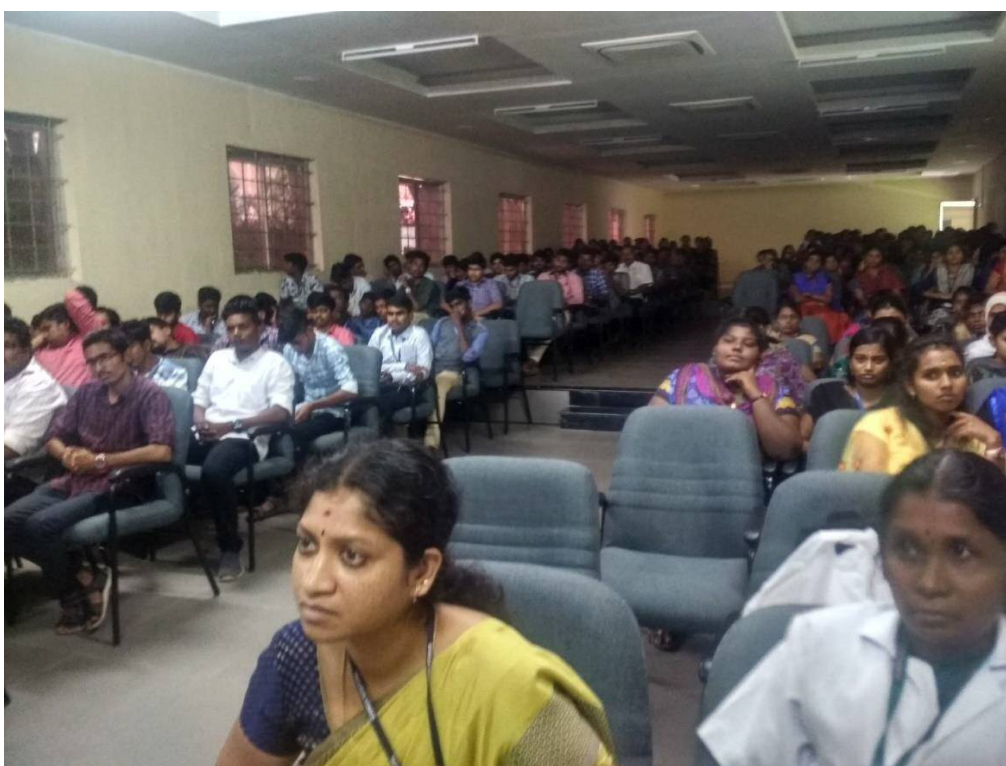
