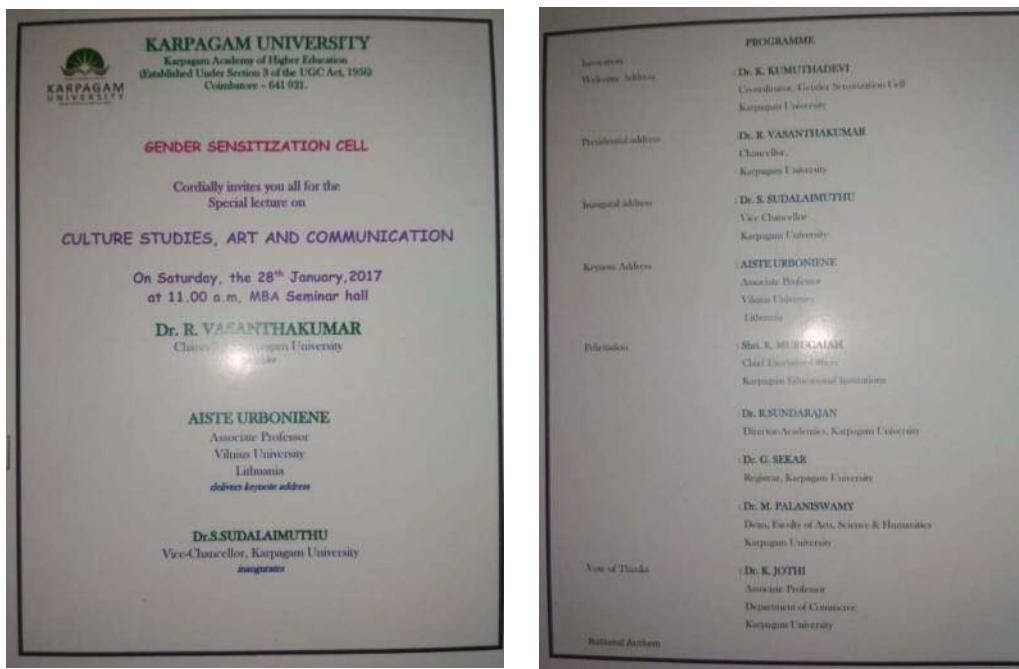

## WORLD BLOOD DONAR DAY

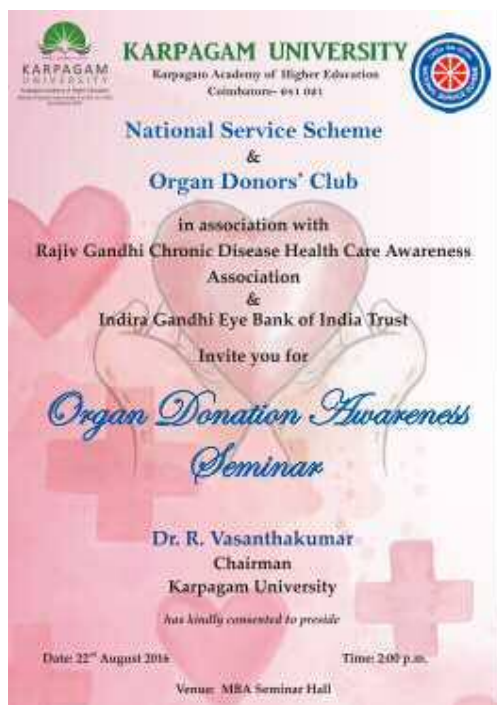
World blood donor day is celebrated throughout the world on 14<sup>th</sup> June of every year. In view of this, the World blood donor day was celebrated on 19<sup>th</sup> June at MBA hall at 10 am. The Department of Biochemistry and National Service Scheme (NSS) jointly organized the program and all the faculty members and students (300) from various discipline attended the programme. The chief guest for the function was Mr. Arun Gokuldoss, Senior citizen, Centurian blood donor, Coimbatore. Two more special invitees were Mr. K.K. Ravi, Akshith Foundation, Coimbatore. and Dr. Kanmani Devi, Pathologist, Blood bank in charge of Karpagam Faculty of Medical Sciences and Research (KFMSR), Coimbatore . All the chief guests were honored by Dr. S. Dharmaraj, NSS coordinator, KAHE, Dr. A. Ramakrishnan, Program coordinator, Dr. K. Devaki, HoD, Department of Biochemistry, KAHE. The function was started with prayer and followed by welcome address by Dr. K. Devaki, Head Department of Biochemistry. During her address she told the blood donor day vision of this year is “SAFE BLOOD FOR ALL’ and narrated the objective of this year according to WHO. One of the objective is the identification and recognition of continuous blood donors and appreciate their service. In view of this Mr. Arun Gokuldoss, who donated blood more than 150 times for the past fifty years, addressed the students and highlighted the importance of blood donation and its benefits. Mr. K.K. Ravi has delivered the activities carried out by Akshith Foundation where they donate blood at any time and his adaptation of Thalasaemic children for whom continuous blood donation is required. Dr. Kanmani Devi elaborated the facts and myths of blood donation and blood banking services at KFMSR, Coimbatore. The function came to an end with vote of thanks by Dr. S. ## ORGAN DONATION CAMP





“National Service Scheme of Karpagam University , Coimbatore in association with Rajiv Gandhi Chronic Disease Health Care Awareness Association & Indira Gandhi Eye Bank of India Trust conducted “Organ Donation Awareness Seminar” on 22nd August, 2016 at Karpagam University Campus. It was organized to create awareness about organ donation in society. About 250 volunteers of our University from all the departments attended. It is expected that they will now help in educating others regarding the need for organ donation.

Sri C.P.Perumaal- Organizing Secretary, the Coordinator of Rajiv Gandhi Chronic Disease Health Care Awareness Association & Indira Gandhi Eye Bank of India Trust discussed government guidelines and initiatives in deceased donor organ donation.

The seminar was inaugurated by Dr. G. Sekar, Registrar, Karpagam University.

Dr.Prasanth Vijyanth, Multi Organ Transplant Surgeon, Kovai Medical Centre & Hospital, Coimbatore, in his speech about Heart & Lung Transplantation, said Coimbatore hospitals have successfully harvested organs through 61 Cadaver transplantation, taking the number to 51 kidneys, 28 livers, 15 hearts and 2 lungs. Doctors from Coimbatore claim that the achievement had been successful because of the awareness among the public and the technology that is available.

Dr. J. K. B. C. Parthiban, Neuro & Spine Surgeon, Kovai Medical Centre & Hospital, Coimbatore enlightened the gathering about the importance of cadaver (brain-dead donor) donations. Organs such as the liver, heart, kidneys, pancreas, small bowel and corneas could



be retrieved from such donors. “Increasing awareness about cadaver organ donations can result in precious lives being saved. If all of us agree to donate our organs after death, perhaps this will be more successful,” he emphasized. He elucidated the concept of brain death, the irreversible loss of all brain functions.

“Brain death certification is done after the patient satisfies certain irreversible criteria. The certification is carried out by a team of doctors appointed by the state, including a neurologist. The test is repeated after six hours before certification is given,” he shared.

Dr. Anand Vijay, Gem Hospital, Coimbatore, Liver Transplant Surgeon, spoke about preventive aspects of liver disease.

Skin Transplant Surgeon, Dr. Sanjai Ram Kumar. V. S., Ganga Hospital, Coimbatore gave awareness on Skin transplantation and also issued pamphlets.

Cornea Donations: "People should begin taking up eye donation as a family tradition," Mr. Prabhakar – Eye Bank Manager, Aravind Eye Care System, Coimbatore.

Dr. A. Dharmaraj, Co-ordinator of the NSS gave Vote of Thanks “This seminar gave us so much information that can help us to eradicate the myths and the fears people have about organ donation”.

## CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- ❖ If leave is requested for reasons of illness for more than two days, the leave application along with a medical certificate should be submitted by the parents / local guardian on or before the 3rd day of illness. A fitness certificate from the Doctor who treated the student should be submitted on the day of rejoining the Institution.
- ❖ Smoking is strictly prohibited inside the campus.
- ❖ Students found using intoxicants and drugs will be summarily dismissed.
- ❖ In case of cancellation of a class, students have to go to the library.
- ❖ Students should refrain from participating in any kind of political or communal activities.
- ❖ Students found guilty of damaging, destroying University property should replace the same at their own cost.
- ❖ Students should not sit on the parapet walls or on the steps or staircases.
- ❖ Students found guilty of writing, scribbling, painting on the walls, desks etc., will be penalized suitably with fine. Students must identify those who cause damage to the University property and report the same to the Registrar.
- ❖ Students found guilty of using foul language or behaving rudely towards the fellow students / staff members, will be expelled from the University.

- ❖ Any requisition or letter written by the student to the Registrar should be sent through the tutor, the HOD and the Dean concerned.
- ❖ If any student directly or indirectly commits, participates, abets or propagates ragging shall be punished as per the Anti-ragging Guidelines of UGC.
- ❖ Gender equality is maintained in the campus and students are expected to honour this.
- ❖ Sexual harassment is a serious offence. The students involved in the sexual harassment shall be expelled from the institution.
- ❖ During the working hours of the University keeping and/or using the cell phone inside the University campus is prohibited. The cell phone will be confiscated if found in use and will be returned only after the completion of the course. Hostellers are permitted to use the cell phone within the hostel premises before or after the silent hours.
- ❖ Outsiders will not be permitted to meet the students during working hours.
- ❖ Students having any grievance are advised to present the grievance before the Grievance Redressal Committee.
- ❖ Students should wear helmet while riding their two-wheelers. Students coming without helmet will not be allowed inside the campus.
- ❖ The campus is plastic free and the students are advised not to use plastics for any purpose.
- ❖ The cultural events organized by students should be decent and should reflect the reputation of the Institution.
- ❖ The students of sports & cultural activities should take up the results of sports / cultural with competitive spirit.
- ❖ Possession / use of weapon, explosives or destructive devices totally prohibited.
- ❖ Theft or unauthorized access to others resources are crimes.
- ❖ Students are not permitted to provide audio and video clipping of any activity on the campus to media or social network without prior permission.
- ❖ Hostellers should follow the rules and regulations of the hostel ardently.
- ❖ Students should not involve in any malpractices during the examinations.

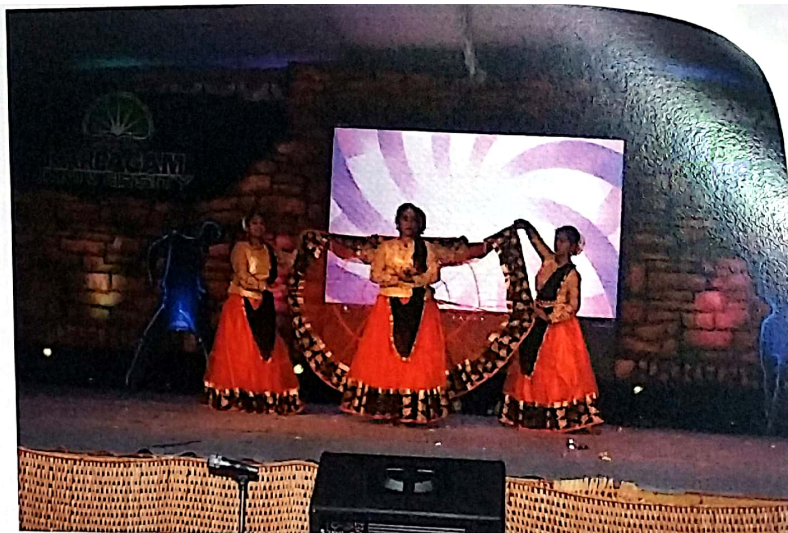















## PRANAYA 2016
